The Annual Calendar

Key interactions with IBO Biggest-impact tasks

- Financial deadlines
- Assessment starters and deadlines
- Procedural pivot points

Template Annual Calendar

For an old year (M21) in DP.

I use Calendarpedia for the day/date structure, then adapt.

This example calendar includes the main items for 'at-a-glance' use only.

Finances

- Annual fees invoiced: 31 August
- Registration fees invoiced: 15 December
- Other invoices as needed (e.g. PD, conferences, evaluation fees etc.)
- Billing contact set on My School, per programme.

Final demands sent for unseen invoices? Payment due dated yesterday?

It's not you - but pay promptly to avoid registration difficulties.

Release of assessment material

- MYP Partially completed unit planners (for ePortfolio subjects) and this year's chosen global context released: 1 November (1 May)
- MYP interdisciplinary exam pre-release material: 1 April (1 October)
- MYP exam packs: download 7 days before each exam
- TOK Essay titles: 1 September (1 March)
- **DP Subject-specific** pre-releases e.g. Business Management; Film; Computer Science differing dates, can change with updated guides.

Registering students

- MYP all MYP 5 students for at least Personal Project: 20 October (20 April)
 - Special request language provision request for personal project: 1 year earlier (20 Oct/Apr of MYP4)
- **CP & DP**: 15 November (15 May)
 - Special request Language A: 1 year earlier (15 Nov/May of DP1)
- MYP, CP & DP Inclusive Access Arrangements: 15 November (15 May)

Fringe cases:

- Groups 3-6 responses in special request language: 15 Nov (15 May) of DP 1.
- Non-regular Diplomas: 15 Nov (15 May) of DP 1.

Uploading coursework

- **eCoursework** (DP/CP) platform opens: **15 January** (15 July)
- **ePortfolio** (MYP) platform opens: **1 February** (1 August)
- DP/CP Early Component deadline (TOK, EE, Lang A HL, Arts): 15 March (15 September)
- Personal & Reflective Projects, ePortfolios, DP/CP IAs deadline: 20 April (20 October)
- DP/CP **EAs**: 30 April (30 October)

Exams & Results

- Global Exam Schedule on PRC 2 years in advance
- Exam **re-schedule requests**: 15 March (15 September)
- First exam: typically the last Monday/Tuesday of April
- Last exam: typically penultimate week of May
- Consider internal (mock) exams timing

Results:

- **Pre-release** available to you: 5 July
- Students: 6 July
- DP Coordinator's Results Analysis Template on my website (kpburgess.com/leadership-resources)
- Analysis with staff: pre-term 1?

Assessment Calendars

DPCP: a must

MYP: growing in prominence

- Required by IB to spread assessment load
- Obligated to foster the wellbeing
- What is calendarable?
- Whole programme in advance
- Cemented dates

"The school demonstrates in its systems, processes and policies attention to the social, emotional, and physical well-being of its students and teachers." (0202-03-0200)

"[The DPC develops] a calendar of **internal** deadlines for IB assessments, the EE, and completion of CAS requirements... This calendar should take into consideration students' involvement in extra-curricular activities, important school events, daily homework requirements and family obligations." *DP Principles into Practice*.

"The school schedule or calendar indicates a balanced approach to assessment deadlines for IA, EA, EE, CAS." *Guide to Programme Evaluation*

Benefits of a well-made assessment calendar

- Students and teachers can **realistically plan** their work
- Recognises that all work cannot be done at once
- Recognises that students undertake **1 Diploma**, not 9 separate components
- Reduces stress on students
- Allows time for teachers to:
 - Feedback
 - Check authenticity
 - Mark
 - Standardise
 - Prepare moderation **samples**

CEMENTING DATES

All qualifying assessment types must go in the calendar

Dates are cemented: immovable

Consider carefully the 2-year programme. Plan backwards from assessment dates

Internal & External Assessment **Draft** submissions

Internal & External Assessment Final submissions

Mid-courses and mocks

Visual Arts exhibitions and interviews which are conducted as a requirement of the DP course

Theory of Knowledge Exhibitions

Theory of Knowledge Essay **Draft and Final** submissions

In class tests taking place under timed and/or silent conditions

In class tests over 15 minutes.

Theatre and Music performances which are conducted as a requirement of the DP course

Extended Essay interim written milestones

Extended Essay supervisor formal checkpoints

Extended Essay Draft and Final submissions

QUALIFYING ASSESSMENT TYPES

(What is Calendarable?)

Step 1: Setup your Calendar

- Correct day/dates
- Include holidays and exam dates
- Add in whole cohort deadlines (EE, TOK, mocks...)
- Include major uni application dates
- Colour code days to protect them (i.e. red for no entries, grey for holidays, green for special days)

Sample Calendar

- Includes both years for a cohort
- Is maintained as a live cloud doc
- Students, parents, teachers all refer to the same live file
- Subject leads can write into it at draft stage
- Your job is to spread load: consider subjects in same group on same day, small courses etc.
- Students empowered to insist on the plan being followed.

Subject Leads submit their preferred dates for all Qualifying Assessments

Draft calendar to Subject Leads for proofing

June 8th

Final calendar approved by Senior Leadership Team 10th

Published as the cemented 2-year calendar to community
